

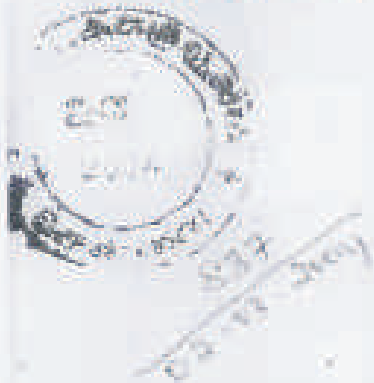

Nathalla Andikeravulu Gupta Son of Nathalla Sampathu Chetty Hindu aged 63 years residing at no 14 Vasa Street Kiput Madhav 600 010 (2) Thalikonda Rameshchandra Son of Thalikonda Rameshanna Chetty aged 67 Years residing at no 6 15th Avenue Herrington Road Madhav 600 031 hereinafter called the Authors of the Trust preamble Whereas 1985 is the Year of platinum Jubilee (75th Birth day) of Kulapathi Dr. S. Radhakrishna Jishi who has devoted himself to the Cause of education — W. Andikeravulu Gupta T. Rameshchandra — 2 —

is a spirit of dedication in a unique manner and at great sacrifice to himself to the cause and promotion of education He served the Hindu Theological High School with conspicuous efficiency and singular devotion for a memorable period of 41 years — 15 years as a teacher and abyan a very successful and distinguished Headmaster In 1964 His Holiness Jagadguru Sri Chandrasekara Saraswati of Kanchi Karnataka peetham conferred on him the prestigious title of Kulapathi In the same year he was the recipient of the National Award for Teachers at the hands of Dr. S.
